

MINUTES
EAGAR CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING
October 31, 2007

ITEM #3: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF LIGHTING FOR CEMETERY FOR SAFETY/SECURITY REASONS.

Chair Becky Pacey said that she would talk to Public Works Director Elwin Browning about solar security lights. Marion Wiltbank said she would look into grants for the security lights. Chair Becky Pacey said that if a gate and fence could be placed on the south side it would help with security. Mrs. Pacey would talk to Elwin about the fence/gate.

ITEM #4: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF PAYMENT ON CEMETERY PLOTS THAT HAVE BEEN RESERVED AND NOT PAID ON OR COMPLETELY PAID.

Marion Wiltbank reported that the fees for plots changed from \$175.00 to \$500.00 on April 1, 2003. Mrs. Wiltbank said that there were quit a few people who reserved plots right before the fee change who had not paid any money down or made payments on the plots. Mrs. Wiltbank was given direction from Town Manager Bill Greenwood to contact the people who had not paid on plots and let them know that the cost of plots were \$500.00 each. Majority of the cemetery committee members said that Town Manager Bill Greenwood's decision was fair.

ITEM #5: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF ADDING A NEW PART TO THE CEMETERY

Chair Becky Pacey directed Marion Wiltbank to contact Finance Administrator Rick Pinckard and find out for sure what the cemeteries budget

amount is. Chair Becky Pacey also, asked Mrs. Wiltbank to look into lights and expansion grants for the cemetery.

ITEM #6: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF TREES FOR CEMETERY AND WATERING.

Chair Becky Pacey said she would talk to Public Works Director Elwin Browning about having Public Works Crewman Sheldon Deverse water trees and bushes through the winter, at least once a month. Mrs. Pacey said she would also ask about putting in water pipes to each tree to water trees during summer. Chair Becky Pacey said to bring this item back next agenda and also put on the next agenda that we need a new committee person to replace Tom Rasmussen. and Eagle Scout projects for cemetery.

ITEM #7: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION ON FILLING OF HOLES WHERE DEAD TREES WERE FOR SAFETY REASONS (GET WITH DEAN ARONSON).

Chair Becky Pacey said she would talk to Public Works Director Elwin Browning or Dean Aronson about the crew filling in the holes with dirt where the dead trees were removed for safety reasons.

ITEM #8: CONSIDERATION AND DISCUSSION OF RIP-RAP AT CEMETERY.

Chair Becky Pacey said that there was still silt washing into other parts of cemetery from the hill. It needed to have riprap like Councilor James Nelson and Public Works Director Elwin Browning had said. Also, there was a lot of trash/rusted metal in the rock that had been placed against the hill. Mrs. Pacey will talk to Public Works Director Elwin Browning about it.
