

MINUTES  
EAGAR CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING  
May 7, 2008  
10:00 a.m.

Eagar Cemetery Committee Chairwoman Becky Pacey welcomed those present and called meeting to order at the Cemetery. All members were present except for Norma Coddington and Mayor Gloria Eagar. New member Kim Holaway.

**ITEM #3: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF TREE AND SHRUB PROGRAM AND THE PLACEMENT OF NEW TREES/BUSHES.**

Marion ordered nine Austrian Pines and five Spartan Junipers to place at Cemetery. Becky said she would try to find a probationer who needed community hours to dig the holes for the trees or talk to Brady Finch to see if his inmate crew could do the holes.

**ITEM #4: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF THE FLOWERS FOR PLANTERS.**

Becky donated daylilies and other perennials for the planters at the cemetery. Marion and Becky transplanted the plants and Becky has been watering them. Becky had also planted flower seeds in the planters.

**ITEM #5: DISCUSSION AND VIEWING OF THE LANDSCAPING AT THE CEMETERY THAT WAS COMPLETED BY PUBLIC WORKS.**

The rocks that the Public Works crew had placed at the side of the hill to stop erosion seems to be helping. Dean Aronson and his inmate crew also placed rip/rap (rock), and a rock ditch down the old road on the north of the cemetery to help stop the silt from burying the new trees and silting in the flower bed at the bottom Northeast corner. At this time we are waiting for monsoon rains to see if this will work. This has been a long-standing problem, which we hope has been corrected.

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**ITEM #6: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF REPOSITIONING THE GRAVE OF MARY K. EAGAR.**

Marion will write a letter to the family of Mary K. Eagar and tell them that her grave needs to be moved back into position with the other family plots. And ask them if they want to have a small service at that time to rededicate the grave. The town will not charge for the disinterment and re-burial. We will get from them written permission for the removal and repositioning.

**ITEM #7: CONSIDERATION AND DISCUSSION OF THE FOOTSTONES.**

Marion had the list for fifty-one footstones for the new section ready. Becky and Marion will check with Rick on the budget for the cemetery and order the footstones.

**ITEM #8: DISCUSSION OF CLEAN UP OF CEMETERY ON TOWNS CLEAN UP DAY.**

Everyone will bring their shovels and rakes to take out the dead trees and fill holes with dirt.

**ITEM #9: DISCUSSION OF GPS OF CEMETERY.**

Marion explained that the GPS of the cemetery would help tie in the cemetery computer program (Caselle) with the cemetery maps. When a name/information was entered on the deceased the name would automatically be entered onto the map.

**ITEM #10: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF CEMETERY DEEDS OR CERTIFICATE FOR CEMETERY PLOTS TO SHOW OWNERSHIP.**

Marion said that a resolution/ordinance would need to be written for the change. And any other changes in the cemetery code would be made at that time. Marion was instructed to look at other towns/cities cemetery ordinances so the committee could get ideas on what they wanted to change/keep.

**ITEM #11: ADJOURNMENT.**

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20p.m. Next meeting will be in August.
